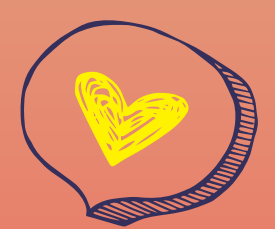
### FAMILY TALK
